REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and restriction of chemicals) is a European Union Commissions regulation pertinent to the safe use of chemicals (EC1907/2006). This regulation entered into force in June 2007 and replaced a number of EU directives and regulations, merging them into a single system. The purpose of this regulation is to ensure sufficient levels of protection for human health and the environment. The regulation imposes controls that identify, assess and allow businesses to manage chemical substances.

Assembly Contracts Ltd will comply with these regulations as listed below:-

- ACL site compliance against REACH candidate list
- Where applicable receive and assess REACH information from our suppliers
- Periodic assessment and evaluation of our supply chain to ensure compliance
- Produce and distribute a policy of compliance to our supply chain (as applicable)
- Monitor the candidate list as part of the ACL oversight and compliance requirements
- Periodic review of our REACH compliance program
